Our problem solving skills are improving during Mathematics and we have been practising different strategies for solving addition and subtraction stories. We have been learning which words give us a clue about the strategy needed to solve the problem.

We enjoyed learning about Emergency's during our visit from Constable Care and learnt how to identify an emergency and what numbers to ring when we need help.









The Pre-Primaries have had a wonderful Term 2 and we have learnt so many fun things.

In Literacy we have enjoyed learning about Cause and Effect and loved reading about Sneezy the Snowman and Click Clack Moo! We are getting really good at our writing and have started to create our own sentences using capital letters, full stops and adjectives. We have also been using our VCOP and trying to add connectives into our sentences.

We have finished our unit of Science and are now extremely excited to create our sail boats in STEM. In digital Technologies we have consolidated our learning on Hardware and Software and are now working on how we can be safe when using the internet. We know that we do not give out our name, address and school and always ask an adult if we need help.

We have continued with our learning of Bush Tucker and know the names of many Bush Tucker plants - Pig Face, Finger Limes and Warrigal Greens.


