At Two Rocks Primary school our educational music program is full of opportunities to perform, sing, rap, dance, compose and most importantly learn instruments.

<u>Ukuleles</u>

Instruments

Junior grades will begin to learn to play music on the glockenspiel as it is straightforward and mimics the piano keys. Glockenspiels give a great foundation from which to develop reading music and to understand timing. The junior years will also have great fun playing on a variety of percussion instruments to gain an understanding of tempo, beat and dynamics.

The middle classes, Years 3 and 4 will learn the recorder, enforcing the reading of notes with a woodwind instrument as well as learning to position their fingers. Fingering on the recorder directly relates to the fingering on the saxophone and clarinet.

Year 5 and 6 as well as Year 4 in the second half of the year will continue their studies of the ukulele. This stringed instrument is a great introduction into the stringed family and helps develop the students understanding of chord patterns and progressions.

Junior and Senior Choirs

There will be a senior and a junior choir this year. The Senior Choir will perform at all major school events including WAGSMS at the Crown theatre. In 2021 WAGSMS was a

huge success for the school, demonstrating their best performance to date! Other school events include the ANZAC Ceremony and Graduation. Both Choirs will perform at the 'Music of the Night' Concert where willing participants get to show off their talents on stage.
