

This is the last newsletter for 2020. Unbelievably it has been a year since we welcomed our students for the start of the year and what an amazing but unusual year it has been. One we will all remember and will I am sure, all look back and say, "Do you remember 2020, the year of Coronavirus?"

The year has ended well with the Year Six students participating in a Graduation Ceremony, a Graduation Dinner and an Excursion to Darklight. They all thoroughly enjoyed these experiences. We held two Book Award Assemblies to enable parents to attend to see their children receive their Book Prizes. We have had Mega Reward for the students who have remained in Good Standing, a Faction Reward for the winning Faction and a Fun Day for all of the students as a reward for their hard work over the whole year.

We have had a Reading Nights Assembly to enable us to acknowledge all our dedicated readers. 65 students who had read 5 or 6 nights consistently received a Silver Certificate and 63 students who read 7 nights consistently received a Gold Certificate. This was live streamed for parents.


Pre-Primary

Wanneroo Museum. The children have enjoyed exploring the 'big school' and getting to visit a new play area each week.








week with Christmas activities which included our Christmas Assembly where we all sung our hearts out.

and students had a blast! On Wednesday we celebrated our end of year excursion at Darklight Laser Tag! We are so proud of you and wish you all the very best for your futures!

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


