We were thrilled to welcome Derek Nannup back to the school for 3 days to build Mia Mia Aboriginal shelters. Derek, the Eco-Education Officer from Yanchep National Park, enthralled the students with his knowledge of the history of the Mia Mia shelters and how they were built. The students thoroughly enjoyed listening to his stories and then actually getting to build their own shelter out of branches and leaves. They learnt how the shelters were built aerodynamically to allow the wind to go over the hut to blow the smoke away, and then pull the heat back into the hut. It was so interesting to hear how the Aboriginal people ensured they smoothed the sand or ground around their huts so they could tell if any animals or snakes had entered their huts while they had been out. It was wonderful to have some parents join us for the incursion.




