

Year One

The Year One students have been super busy! We had our faction carnivals and performed our Assembly. It was an exciting time to share everything we know about the new Bush Tucker Garden. We are so proud of our performance! In Science we have finished learning about day/night and the different types of clouds. In HASS we focused on our environment around us and our community.



It's the last week of Term Three! We have a fun week planned with Talk Up Assembly, Mega reward and a Taco Party to finish off our procedure writing. We have been challenged in Maths with number lines and bridging strategies. We have concluded our unit about the change of technology throughout history in HASS and we have commenced our STEM project for Science! We are looking forward to a well-deserved break so we can come into Term Four ready to go and complete our Year Two journey!



Year Three

This fortnight, we have been writing narratives about aliens landing in our backyards! Our stories are very exciting and include lots of epic fight scenes. In Science, we have been learning about space and how day and night occur. We are currently creating posters to show all of our knowledge. In HASS, we have designed our own Australian flags. For one of our wet weather activities, we drew Minecraft self portraits that our Teachers think look amazing!



Year Four

What an amazing term we have had in Year Four. In Numeracy, we have persisted in learning all our multiplication sums to help solve irregular area, multiples and factors and making factor trees. We also have been investigating odd and even numbers. In Literacy, we have been creative with our adjectives in describing a Mini Beast and trying hard to persuade our Teachers to agree with our arguments. During HASS, we have been investigating First Fleet and learning about life in the 17th Century Britain.

Year Five

The Year Five students have been using MAB blocks to consolidate their learning of division with two, three and four digit numbers. In HASS the students have learnt how to apply an Instructional Intelligence Strategy called Academic Controversy, which resulted in some excellent ideas and thought processes!

Year Six

In Maths, the Year Six students have been learning about volume and how to use a formula to calculate the volume of rectangular based prisms. We really enjoyed our lesson outside using the blocks to build prisms and find the volume. In Literacy, we have been writing balanced discussions about different topics. For our final assessment piece, we have chosen different topics to write and research our balanced discussions on. This term in Science, we have been learning about







natural disasters and have completed a research project on a chosen natural disaster. In groups, we built a model of our natural disaster and presented a speech using the information we collected. We had a lot of fun building our models and planning our presentations!

News from the Chinese Classroom

A few students from Year Three to Year Six who excelled in writing Chinese characters were invited to participate in the annual state Chinese Writing Competition held by the Chinese Language Teachers' Association of Western Australia (CLTAWA). Students are required to produce a small piece of writing in Chinese accompanied by illustrations about any aspect of their own world. Entries were judged on content, handwriting and presentation of work. Participation is voluntary and work is required to be done

independently outside of school hours. Mrs Croker assisted participating students with translating and expressing their thoughts within the set word counts. Four entries were submitted for the competition and a huge congratulations go to Adessa in Year Five and Olivia D in Year Four for receiving a certificate of excellence and a second place in their categories respectively.
