Welcome back to Semester Two. A special welcome to our new students and their Parents/ Caregivers. Please do not hesitate to contact myself or the Associate Principals if you need any assistance or anything clarified. This semester has started really well, with all students settled and working really hard.

Parents and Caregivers are now allowed on school grounds with a two metre social distancing rule in place, however, access to the school is restricted. Between 8:00 to 8:15am students can be dropped off at the gate where they are welcomed by the staff. From 8:15am Parents are welcome to drop their children at the classroom door. After 8:30am no Parents or Visitors are permitted on school grounds unless by appointment, as per Education Department Guidelines. Teachers will be available for meetings after school by appointment only. The gates will open at 2:45pm for pick up. Access is available to the Administration Office however, due to its size, will be restricted to four people at any one time.

Assemblies will resume this term commencing with Year Five Assembly on Wednesday 12 August at 1:30pm. Unfortunately, due to the social distancing rules we are unable to welcome parents. We are therefore going to trial live streaming on our Facebook page of the assemblies in order for parents, family and community members to be able to view the assembly. As the dates of the Assemblies have changed, a new semester planner has been prepared and is available online, on the App and in Admin.

The weather has been quite good and they have had a great time. A big thank you to their teachers Mrs Bell and Ms Stokes and also to Mrs Pinches and Mr Mercer who assisted them. 






Around the School
