Welcome back to Semester Two. A special welcome to our new students and their Parents/ Caregivers. 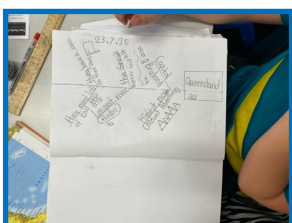
Year Two

Year Six

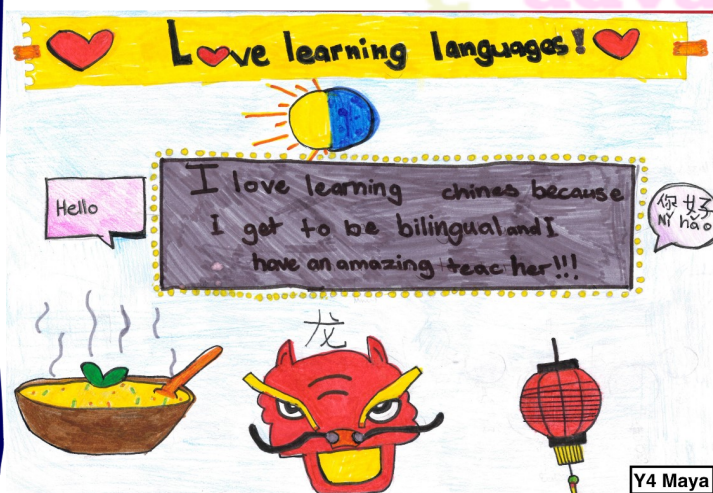

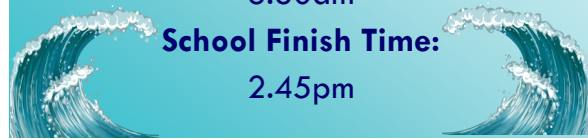
