We enjoyed participating in Cross Country and have started practicing for our assembly.






This term we have been learning how to add two digit numbers in Maths and we have wowed our teachers with how quickly we have learnt to use the formal algorithm and carry the tens across.


YEAR I

Thursday 26th May is National Sorry Day.


On this day we come together as a nation to pay our respects to the Stolen Generation and to remember and recognise the loss and sadness they have felt and continue to feel today.

At Two Rocks we have chosen to commemorate this day by involving the whole school in creating National Sorry Day Flowers.

The Native Hibiscus was chosen to symbolise the scattering of the Stolen Generations. This particular flower was chosen because it is found all over Australia and it is a survivor. Each year group will be involved in creating different Stolen Generation flowers that will be displayed in the Bush Tucker Garden.

It is important that we remember the Stolen Generation because the removal of children broke important cultural, spiritual and family ties and has left a lasting and intergenerational impact on the lives and well-being of Aboriginal and Torres Strait islander peoples.

Our school will also be celebrating National Reconciliation week which occurs between 27th May and 3rd June each year. Reconciliation is all about creating equity and equality, closing the gap and building relationships. Reconciliation requires all Australians to recognise and respect the First people of this land, to acknowledge the past injustices and commit to working towards a more equal and respectful future. The students will be involved in various activities and lessons across the week.






















Making Native Hibiscus flowers for National Sorry Day
