Crazy hair day was super funny, and people had some great ideas.





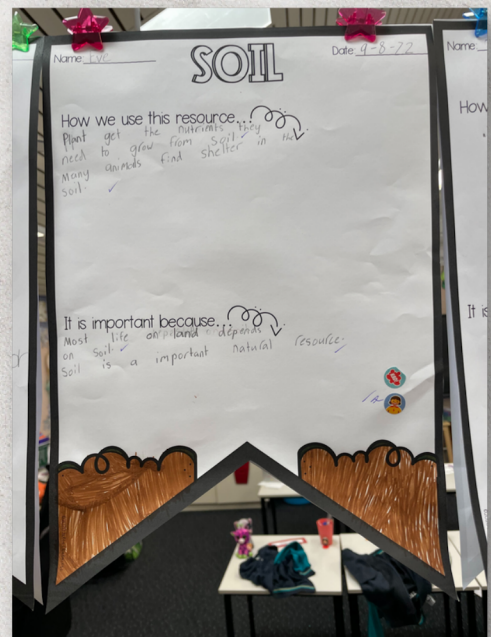
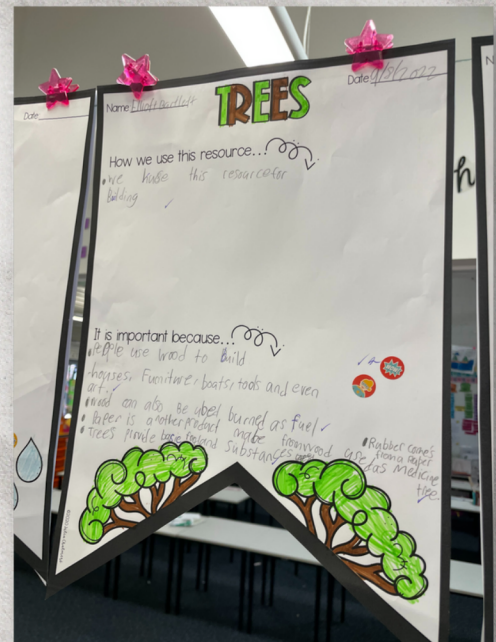
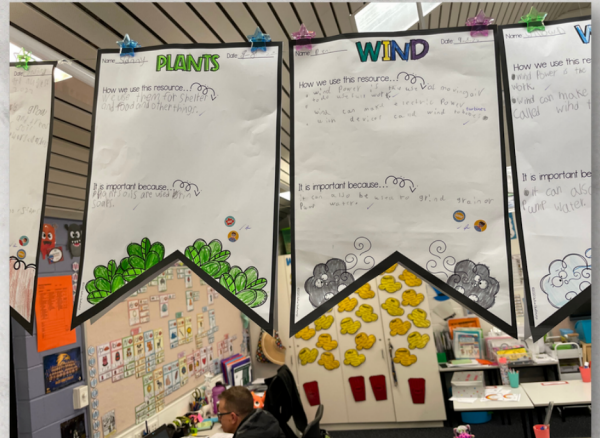
# CLASSROOM UPDATES

These Mathematicians have been revisiting 3 digit numbers and solving worded problems.





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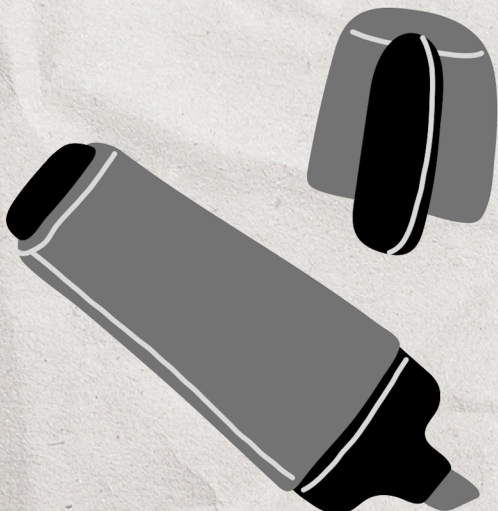
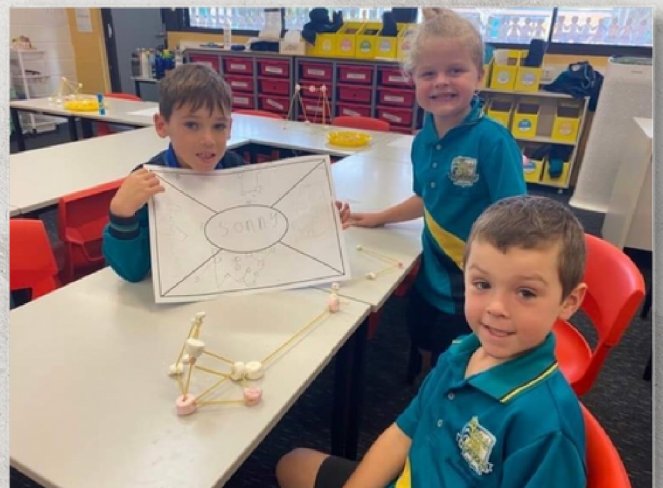
## YEAR 1

In digital Technologies we are working on our iPad skills and learning to change our font size, use the space bar and return at the end of each line.

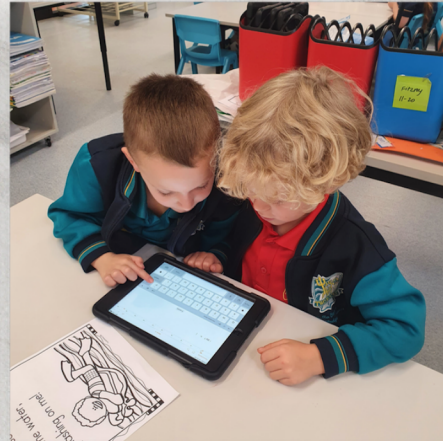
For Health we are learning all about Healthy Eating and what are everyday food and drink choices and what are 'sometimes' foods.

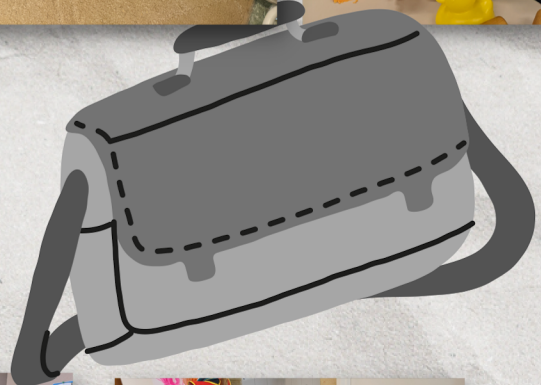


# CLASSROOM UPDATES

### THE BOOST PROGRAM

Do you want to know more about how to help your child learn to read & write? The workshop is split over two sessions which run a week apart.

The Boost program provides information to parents and carers of children in Kindergarten, Pre-primary and Year 1 about how literacy skills develop.

Boost focuses on empowering parents by providing them with the information, resources and confidence to engage their children in enjoyable learning activities within the home; all designed to assist in the development of a firm literacy foundation.

It looks at:

- the sounds in words
- putting sounds and letters together
- how to be a good reader and speller
- building vocabulary and reading comprehension skills



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A free two-part workshop will be held at Two Rocks Primary School on **Tuesday 30th August and Tuesday 6th of September, 2022 from 9.00am to 12.00pm**. It is important that parents attend both sessions. Morning tea will be provided.

The Boost program is an initiative of DSF Literacy Services and is generously funded by the Fogarty Foundation

All parents participating in the sessions will receive a 'Literacy Pack' containing an information booklet, DVD, games, reading captions and other resources (over \$80 in value!) to support what is covered in the workshop.
